Lethie Marsh Lanham, 66, of Tallahassee, peacefully passed away at home Friday, February 17, 2017, in Tallahassee.

Daughter of the late Douglas Hilton Marsh and Sylvia Joan Williams Marsh, who survives, she was born October 24, 1950, in Crites, West Virginia. The family moved to Tallahassee in the early 60's where Lethie graduated from Leon High School. After graduation she worked at the Florida Department of Transportation, and later the Department of Environmental Protection until retirement.

She is also survived by a son, Jason Lee Lanham; brothers, Douglas (Debra) Marsh, Jr., and David (Anne) Marsh; sisters, Christine (Charles) Rabon and Carol Hart; a longtime companion, Neill Wade, all of Tallahassee, a lifelong friend, Iris Corbin of Aurora, CO, as well as numerous nieces, nephews, friends.


