



## Mr. Richard Albert Greene

March 26, 1952 - February 27, 2019

Richard Albert Greene, 66, of Crawfordville, peacefully passed away on Wednesday, February 27, 2019, while in the presence of his loving family.

A son of Albert Edward Greene and Angelina Clara Agnes Zambito Greene, of blessed memory, he was born in Boston, Massachusetts on March 26, 1952. Also preceding him in death is a grandson, Nathan Green. Rich had resided in Crawfordville since 2001, having come from the Tampa and Orlando area.

Retired since 2016, Rich was formerly a Quality Assurance Software Manager for companies such as Microsoft, and his extraordinarily varied career included working on mental telepathy and astral projection studies in recent decades with the federal government and working with Disney World. He earned a Bachelor's of Science from Bellevue University in 2006, had earned various certifications, and strived to always continue learning.

He was a member of Temple Israel in Tallahassee with a keen interest in the study and teaching of Kabbalah. Rich loved trying to win the lottery and is probably still searching for patterns in the numbers! Self-taught with countless sets of law books, Rich loved to argue the legal establishment.

He leaves behind his wife, Abbieann (Misty) Lazarus Greene; stepson, Joel Hammon (wife, Rebecca Green); granddaughters, Harley Hammon, Erin Hammon and Jaime Green; three great-grandchildren; and sisters, Elana Dettore and Geraldine Greene.

The funeral will be held at 11:00 AM, Friday, March 8, 2019, at Abbey Funeral Home, with interment following at Tallahassee Memory Gardens.
