Adeolu David, affectionately known as “AD,” was a beloved husband, father, and brother who passed away on December 28, 2024, at the age of 58. He was born on May 10, 1966, in Kano State, Nigeria, and migrated with his family to Tallahassee, Florida, in June 1978.
