"Miss Lara? Remember your dog, Harley? He's a spirit and he watches over you every day."

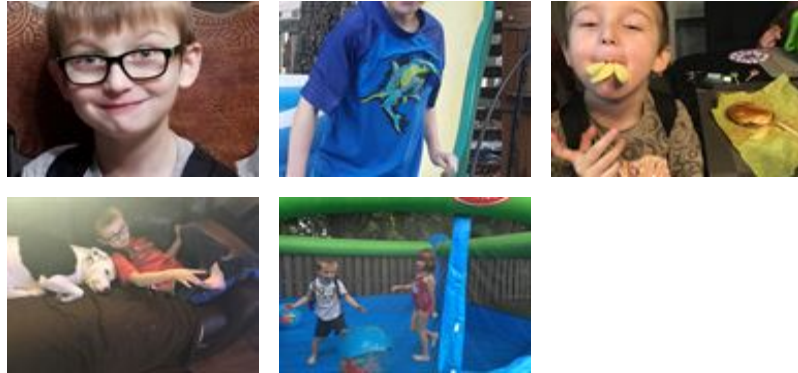
"I know, sweetie. I know."
