Danny Ray Hill, 74, of Tallahassee, passed away on Monday, August 24, 2020, while surrounded by his loving family.

Born in Marianna, Florida on October 19, 1945, he was a son of the late John Henry and Cora Elizabeth Lee Hill. He is also preceded in death by his siblings, Ada Lawson, Marie Smith, Annie Pittman and Vernon Hill; and a very dear friend, Tommy Hollifield.
