A talented carpenter and master tinkerer, he enjoyed Scuba diving, fishing, shooting, being on the water, cooking and was a collector of anything antique.

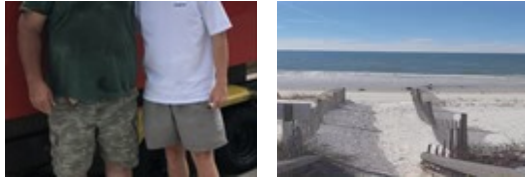
A service to celebrate his life will be held at a later date.
