Doyle Maxion Hanna, 71, passed away on Monday, July 11, 2022. He was born in Tallahassee, Florida to Burrell Jefferson and Annie Lois Pitts Hanna on February 17, 1951.

Doyle lived over 70 years of his life with polio, but it never slowed him down. He was a computer whiz and a perfectionist, which earned him a dual degree in Finance and Accounting from Florida State University. For 33 years, he designed and built local government electronic reporting systems for the Department of Financial Services of Florida. Doyle was also one of the original founders and first trumpet of Tallahassee Swing Band and was affiliated with Evangel Assembly of God. He loved travelling and photography.
