Elvy Glenn Carter, 84, of Tallahassee, Florida, passed away peacefully at home on Thursday, June 29, 2023.

A son of Glenn Franklin Carter and Verlie Cobb Carter, he was born in Tallahassee, Florida, on October 16, 1938. He attained the rank of Lance Corporal while serving in the United States Marine Corps from 1957 – 1960. Except for the four years he lived in Maine, he was a lifelong resident of Tallahassee. Before retiring, he was a supervisor for Taul Enterprises. He was a member of Beth Page United Methodist Church in Grady County, Georgia.

He will best be remembered for enjoying his family and friends, archery, fishing, hunting and baseball. He was a founding member of the Horse Creek Traditional Archery Club; a lifetime member of Traditional Bowhunters of Florida; and a member of the Tallahassee Archery Club. He won many archery competitions over the years. He was best known for saying “watch this” before taking his shot at competition targets. He loved fishing on Lake McBride and Lake Iamonia and hosted many fish fries for family and friends.

He is survived by his wife of 37 years, Kathy Aker Carter; children, George Carter (wife, Tara), Rick Carter (wife, Marci), Terri Carter and Bonnie Carter; grandchildren, Cade Carter, Shane Carter, Beau Carter and Bennett Carter; six great-grandchildren; and siblings, Herbert John Carter and Amanda Carter.
