George F. Ewing, 82, passed away peacefully at home on August 29, 2024, in Tallahassee, Florida. He was born to the late Leonard F. Ewing and Johnnie Wiggins Ewing on November 15, 1941, in Douglas, GA. He was a graduate of Leon High School and went on to graduate from the Florida State University Business School. He proudly served in the United States Army National Guard.

In 1966 George founded George F. Ewing Insurance Company. He later renamed the company in 1998 to First Franklin Financial Services in honor of his late father, Leonard Franklin Ewing. He was a mentor to all the staff at First Franklin.
