Mr. Leroy Gibson, 90, died on April 12, 2022, in Tallahassee, Florida. He was born June 21, 1931, in Laurel, Mississippi, to William Amos and Corine Blackledge Gibson.

After graduating high school, Mr. Gibson joined the Army. He retired with the rank of Sergeant First Class in 1967 after 21 years of service of honorable and faithful service.
