Martyne Hoppe, 89, of Tallahassee, Florida, passed away peacefully at her home on Jan. 14, 2026. Born in Miami on February 19, 1936, to George and Elizabeth Hahn, she lived a long and meaningful life grounded in conviction, family, and quiet generosity.

Martyne married Herman Lewis “Bud” Hoppe, her husband of 60 years, and together they raised 7 children. She believed that character, strength, and self-reliance were the best tools she could give her children, and she offered them with clarity and high expectations. Her home was one of loyalty, love, and togetherness, where showing up for one another was the rule, not the exception.
