



Mr. Robert Joel Krzeminski

December 15, 1943 - January 29, 2024

'Robert "Bob" Joel Krzeminski, 80, passed away on Monday, January 29, 2024. He was born in Gary, Indiana, on December 15, 1943, to Joseph Arthur and Emily Josefovsky Krzeminski.

Bob grew up in Gary, Indiana and attended Emerson High School, where he met the love of his life, Sandy. They were inseparable and were married on May 7, 1966. He enlisted in the Army in 1966 and proudly served his country overseas in the Vietnam War. Upon his return, he completed his studies at Purdue University, earning bachelors and masters degrees in civil engineering. He became a professional engineer and began working for the State of Florida Department of Transportation in Fort Lauderdale, Florida in 1974, and then in 1977, in Tallahassee, Florida. He retired in 2000. Bob attended Tallahassee Heights United Methodist Church and Killearn United Methodist Church where he participated in bible studies, sang with the choir, played in the handbell choir, and mentored couples preparing for marriage.

Bob enjoyed spending time with his family and was always an enthusiastic supporter of his children and grandchildren in all of their activities, but most of all, he enjoyed being with his beloved wife, Sandy. They continued to be inseparable through their 57 years of marriage. They could often be found having lunch together at his favorite restaurants, Cabos and Island Wings. He is known for his generosity and great love for his family and friends.

Bob is survived by his adoring wife, Sandra “Sandy” Jean Krzeminski; his children, James Krzeminski (Carey) and Melissa Dockstader (Darryll); his grandchildren, Luke Krzeminski, Elizabeth Auerbach (Jacob), Gus Dockstader, Maria Dockstader, and Catherine Dockstader; among many other family members and friends.

A memorial service will be held on Sunday, February 11, 2024, at 4:30 pm at Killlearn United Methodist Church, followed by a reception.

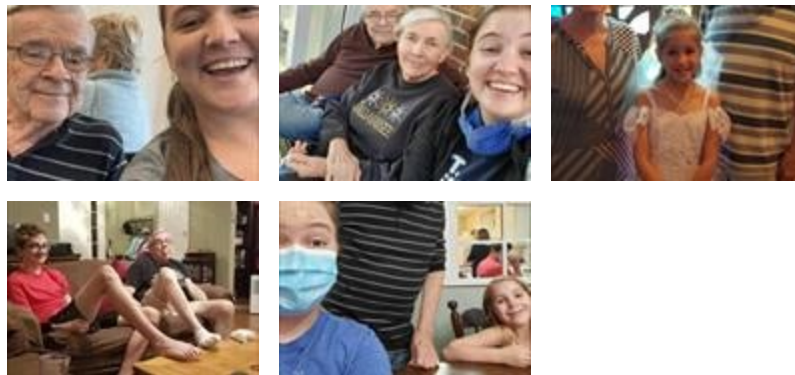
