Shirley Coleman, born August 25th, 1933, passed away Thursday, February 24th, 2022, at the age of 88. She was preceded in death by her parents, Hazel (Barnhart) and Clairon K. West; sisters, Erma Cheney, Naomi Welty, Margy West and the love of her life, her husband, Henry Coleman.
