Tommie Lee Busbee, 81, of Tallahassee, passed away on Sunday, May 2, 2021.

Born in Danville, Illinois on February 2, 1940, he was a son of the late Ben H. Busbee and Frances Charlotte Faford Busbee. He is also preceded in death by a sister, Pamela Busbee Knott; and a brother, Richard Knott.
