



Mr. Troy D. Brewer

May 14, 1936 - May 21, 2025

Troy D. Brewer, affectionately known to many as “Buddy,” passed away peacefully on May 21, 2025, at the age of 89, at the Big Bend Hospice House in Tallahassee, Florida, after a courageous battle with Parkinson’s disease. He now joins his beloved wife of 65 years, Linda Faye, who preceded him in death.

Born in Chipley, Florida, on May 14, 1936, Troy lived a life of service, hard work, and unwavering dedication to his family and community. At 18, he proudly enlisted in the United States Navy and was stationed in California, where he served as a dental assistant. It was during his time at Camp Pendleton that Troy and Linda welcomed their cherished daughter, Cindy. After his military service, the family settled in Tallahassee, where they added three sons to their family, Tab, Kirk, and Scott. Troy began a distinguished career in law enforcement and corrections, first serving with the Florida Highway Patrol and ultimately retiring from the

Federal Corrections Institute in 1990. Not one to remain idle, he later retired from the state, working with the Florida Lottery driving the “showvan” to events throughout the state. He also drove for Astro Travel where he supported many Florida State University athletic teams with great pride.

A devoted member of Fellowship Baptist Church, Troy served in numerous roles over the years - most notably, driving the church buses countless miles for youth and adult trips. He could even be found singing in the choir on occasion.

Troy is survived by his children, Cindy Brewer Barineau (Richard), Tab Brewer, Kirk Brewer (Jilian), Scott Brewer (Kelley). He was a proud grandfather to Jeremie and Olivia Barineau, Kyle and Jenny Barineau, Alan Brewer, Sean Brewer, Jenna Brewer, Leanna (Brewer) and Cole Pearson, Cole Wesley Brewer, Sarah Kathryn Brewer, Hannah (Brewer) and Chris Marshall, and Amanda Brewer. He also leaves behind great-grandchildren, Matilda and Isabella Barineau, Cayden and Hayes Brewer, Ashton Brewer, Norah Grant, Emmarie Kent, Henry Marshall, and Lake, Brady, and Kase Pearson; sister, Pencie Bell; sisters-in-law, Betty Lee Allen and Reeva Hackney; brother-in-law, Jimmy Brown; honorary brother, Dale (Judy) Locke; and many nieces and nephews.

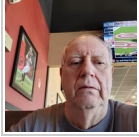
