William Curtis Cox, 77, of Tallahassee, Florida, passed away on Monday, August 15, 2022.

Born February 14, 1945, Bill lived his whole life in Tallahassee. He was a 1964 graduate of Leon High School, later graduating from Florida State University with a degree in Criminology. Bill worked in the criminal justice field and as a Correctional Officer for the federal government until his retirement in 1996.

Bill enlisted in the US Army in 1967, serving with the Military Police in Vietnam from December 1967-December 1968.

Bill was predeceased by his mother, Catherine Curtis Cox. He is survived by his wife Kathy of 37 years, and sons, Robert Cox (Malinda), Roger Cox (Niki), Robert Jackson (Patti) and Stephen Jackson (Lori). His pride and joy were his ten grandchildren and four great-grandchildren.
